I'm stuck in Folsom Prison and time keeps draggin' on

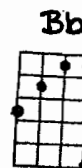
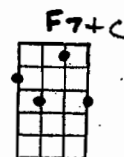
C7 **F**

When I hear that whistle blowin', I hang my head and cry



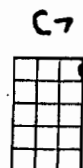
SOLO
